HONORARY DEGREES COMMITTEE CONSTITUTION AS AT 17 OCTOBER 2022

Governance

Honorary Degrees Committee Constitution

1. Committee of the Senate

- (1) The Honorary Degrees Committee is a standing committee of the <u>Senate</u>.
- (2) The committee operates in accordance with the <u>Senate Code</u> and <u>Senate Standing</u> <u>Orders</u> in their application to Senate committees.

2. Role

- (1) The role of the committee is to
 - (a) make recommendations to Senate on the award of honorary degrees; and
 - (b) make recommendations to Senate on the award of the Chancellor's Medal.

3. Membership, Standing Invitees and Executive Officer

- (1) The committee comprises:
 - (a) the Chancellor;
 - (b) the Pro-Chancellor;
 - (c) the Vice-Chancellor
 - (d) the Chair of the Academic Board;
 - (e) two other Senate members appointed by the Senate; and
 - (f) two academic staff members elected to the Committee by the Academic Board.
- (2) The Senior Deputy Vice-Chancellor is a standing invitee to meetings of the committee.
- (3) The University Secretary, or nominee, is Executive Officer to the committee.

4. Term of office

(1) The term of office of members appointed under 3(1)(e) and (f) is two years.

5. Eligibility for a second or subsequent term of office

(1) At the end of a term of office, members appointed under 3(1)(e) and (f) are eligible to be reappointed again up to a maximum of three terms.

6. Quorum

(1) The quorum for the committee is five.

7. Decisions

- (1) All questions which come before the committee are decided by a majority of the members present and voting.
- (2) The chair of the meeting has an ordinary vote and, in the case of an equality of votes, a casting vote.

8. Frequency of meetings

(1) The committee normally meets at least once a year but may meet more frequently if necessary.
