

Submission for a UWA Excellence in Teaching Award *(for submission to the Learning and Teaching Awards Selection Committee)*

The UWA Excellence in Teaching and Service Awards are conferred annually to celebrate and reward excellence in teaching and service that academic staff deliver. They recognise and reward outstanding teaching at the University level.

To be eligible for a UWA Award the staff member/team will have received a faculty Award within 12 months of their submission. The nominees for an Australian Award for University Teaching (AAUT) are selected from the recipients of a UWA Award.

Awards prize money

The Award monies are awarded as a prize and disbursed to the recipients to be used to:

1. Advance the career/s of the recipient/s.

For example: presenting at a conference and costs associated with attending - conference registrations, accommodation and travel.

2. Provide additional resources to support their teaching or activities related to the award.

3. Assist the individual/team to disseminate good practice in learning and teaching.

For example: teaching forums, professional development, seminars, website development/hosting, assistance for publications, teaching relief.

A Written Statement – maximum of 6 A4 pages	Checklist
The core element of an application for a Teaching Award is the written statement in which nominees describe their teaching activities and achievements and must address all four assessment criteria. The written statement should be presented under the following headings, in order.	
1 Synopsis (up to 200 words) written in the third person must cover the nominee's: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> teaching area or discipline teaching experience the particular focus of teaching and teaching methods avoid jargon and use plain English inform the broadest possible audience about the nominee's teaching 	<input type="checkbox"/>
2 Overview of the nominee's teaching and its context	<input type="checkbox"/>
3 Remainder of the statement should address: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> each of the four assessment criteria evidence in support of the claims against the criteria including impact on student learning Lists of references should be included within the 6 pages	<input type="checkbox"/>
