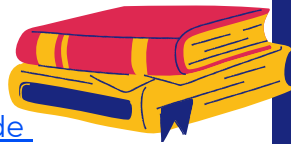
IF YOU DIDN'T CREATE IT, HOW CAN YOU USE IT?

The University is licensed to use some copyright material for educational purposes in the LMS. The copyright notice is automatically added to EchoVideo and Unit Readings.

Here is what Unit Coordinators should do.

1 UNIT READINGS

Book chapters, journal articles, some multimedia should be shared via Unit Readings, not uploaded elsewhere or emailed.

2 ATTRIBUTE

The law protects creators "moral rights" to be identified as the creator of a work. Images in slidesets, quotes in lecture notes, and audioclips all must identify who made them.

3 FIRST SLIDE

If not sharing via EchoVideo, download and insert the Indigenous Recognition and copyright slides at the beginning of your slides.
