(UN)LADYLIKE ACTS RECENT ACQUISITIONS FROM THE CRUTHERS COLLECTION OF WOMEN'S ART

29 August - 5 December 2020 | Lawrence Wilson Art Gallery

The Lawrence Wilson Art Gallery at The University of Western Australia is delighted to announce the opening of *(Un)ladylike Acts*, a new exhibition premiering as the Gallery re-opens on Saturday 29 August.

Taking its title from artist Madison Bycroft's 2013 video work, *(Un)ladylike acts for every lady lacking (Gift to the King)*, the exhibition brings together a selection of contemporary artworks recently acquired or donated to the Cruthers Collection of Women's Art.

Gifted to the University of Western Australia in 2007, the **Cruthers Collection of Women's Art** is the only dedicated public collection of art by Australian women and is one of three major public collections owned by UWA. A complete catalogue of works in the Cruthers Collection was recently made publicly accessible through a new <u>online database</u>.

The latest exhibition featuring artwork from the Cruthers Collection, *(Un)ladylike Acts* examines the ways that 'women artists' wrestle with the connotations and constraints of such a classification.

It features artworks by Madison Bycroft, Penny Bovell, Nancy Borlase, Sarah Contos, Kate Just, Maria Kozic and Toni Warburton that variously reject, embrace and wield gendered perspectives, offering a provocative survey of attitudes toward art practice and its politics.

Devised by former CCWA curator Gemma Weston and delivered by current CCWA curator Lee Kinsella, (Un)ladlylike

Acts brings together a selection of contemporary artworks that challenge expectations of women artists and the work they produce.

(Un)ladylike Acts features painting, knitting, drawing, multimedia, sculpture, photography and video works that examine concepts of self-portraiture, performance and visibility. The exhibition will be on show at Lawrence Wilson Art Gallery until 5 December 2020. It will be accompanied by a series of public talks and tours. For more information visit the LWAG website.
