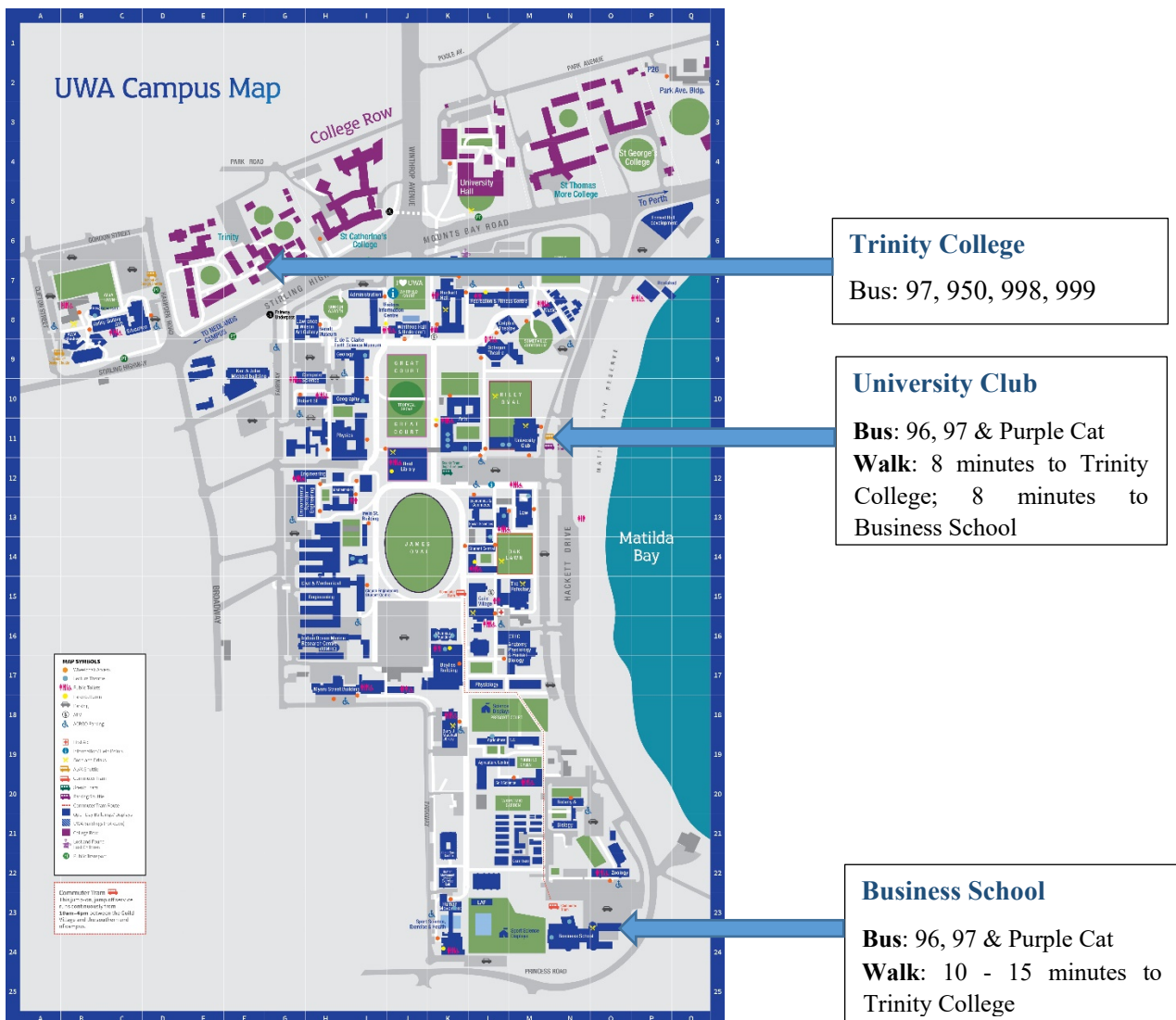
INFORMATION FOR CONFERENCE PARTICIPANTS

1. Conference venue

2. Session structure

Each presentation room is equipped with a USB-enabled computer and projector. Please upload your slides onto the computer before the start of your session.

There will be 16 sessions in the program with 2 papers per session. Each paper is allocated 45 minutes consisting of:

- 1) Student presentation (20 minutes)
- 2) Discussant comments (15 minutes)
- 3) Questions from the audience (10 minutes)

There is a designated chair for each session (listed on the conference program). The session chair will be responsible for keeping time and will assist in facilitating discussion during the session.

3. Ballot for Best Presenter and Best Discussant

When you are attending the conference sessions, please bear in mind that there will be a ballot to determine the best presenter and best discussant (separately for the Economics and Finance sessions). You will cast your vote via SurveyMonkey at the end of the conference. Details to be followed.
