KIDS HOLIDAY PROGRAM

A role in the Kids Holiday Program will see you involved with looking after groups of children aged 5 to 12 years old during the school holidays and guiding them through the program's organized sport and recreation activities. You will work in a team to create enjoyable and memorable sporting experiences for children participating in the program.

Program Coach – the role provides sport coaching and supervision to children, as well as quality customer service to all patrons involved in the program

Program Coordinator – the role will require you to coordinate the daily operations and supervision of coaches involved in the program(s).

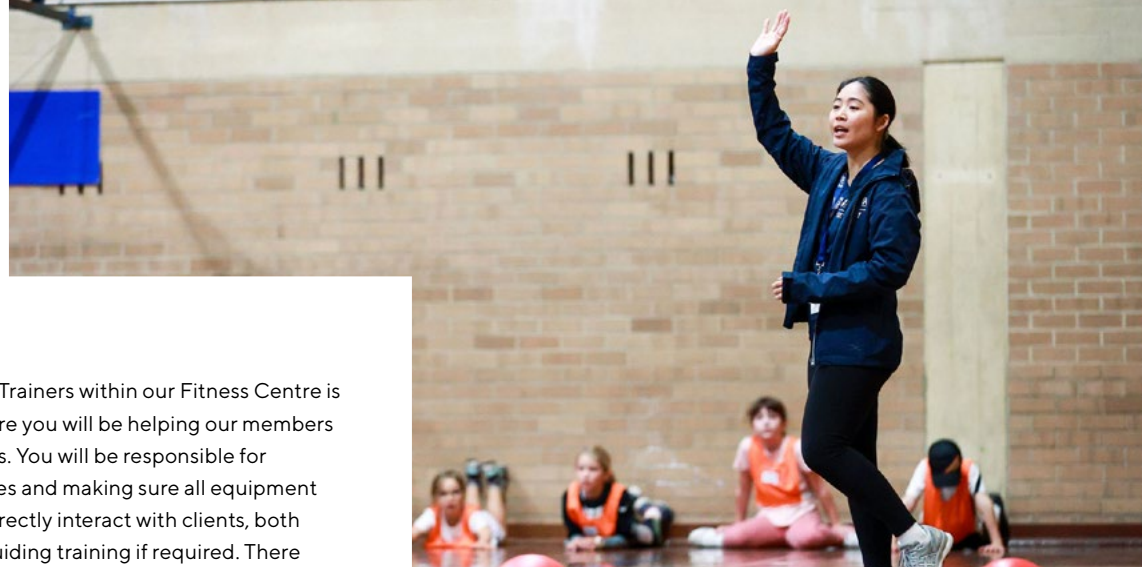
ACTIVE LEADERSHIP UNIT:

UWA Sport delivers the practical component of the UWA's SSEH1104 Active Leadership Unit. An accredited unit that counts towards credit points in an undergraduate degree with a focus on the development of leadership and teamwork skills while undertaking recreational activities including Cycling, Stand Up Paddle boarding and Kayaking.

RECREATIONAL INSTRUCTORS

Lead: this position provides oversight and leads the delivery of the recreational activity tutorials. Facilitates the delivery of approved course content, its core activities and assessment of students. Undertakes risk management activities and first aid procedures. Relevant recreation activity qualifications are required to fulfill this role.

Secondary: This position provides support to the lead Instructor in the delivery of the recreational tutorials. Encourages students to engage in the leadership/team building elements, recording of student attendance and contributes to student assessment. Undertakes activities relevant to risk management and first aid procedures. Working towards relevant recreation qualifications.



FITNESS TRAINER

A role as one of our Fitness Trainers within our Fitness Centre is a dynamic opportunity where you will be helping our members to achieve their fitness goals. You will be responsible for maintaining the gym facilities and making sure all equipment is up to standard. You will directly interact with clients, both answering questions and guiding training if required. There are also opportunities to provide personal training and instruct fitness classes depending on your qualifications.

GROUP FITNESS INSTRUCTOR

Group fitness instructors organize and lead group exercise sessions clearly and safely to participants catering to all fitness levels which can include aerobic exercise, stretching, muscle condition or mediation. Specialised fitness instructors teach popular programs, including Les Mills, Zumba or Yoga. Instructors are expected to watch participants and correct those who are doing exercises improperly.

SWIMMING INSTRUCTOR/COACH

Work as part of the Aquatics team in the delivery of learn to swim and squad programs to participants ranging in age and ability. Instructors are responsible for teaching water confidence and the biomechanical techniques of the four competitive swimming strokes and associated starts and turns, depending on the level and ability of swimmers in their group. Coaches are responsible for the delivery of squad swimming programs and provision of high-quality coaching to all swimmers. Novice and experienced instructors and coaches are considered.

POOL LIFEGUARD

Pool Lifeguards ensure the patron safety of the UWA Aquatic Centre, by preventing and responding to emergencies. They provide quality customer service, a presentable facility and ensure everyone gaining entry is a paid user of the facility.

HOCKEY VENUE ATTENDANT

Hockey Venue Attendants provide quality customer service to patrons of the Hockey Centre, and oversees the coordination of all turn activities. This includes preparing the grounds for play, providing booking support, taking gate fee payments, and operating scoreboards.

GRADUATE OFFICER ROLES

If you are currently studying at UWA or have graduated from UWA within the past 2 years, you are eligible to join the team as a graduate officer. As a graduate officer you will support the design and delivery of our programs, maintain relationships with our stakeholders, and gain experience working in the Sport and Fitness industry.
