

2020 UWA Safer Communities Award

Information Sheet

The University of Western Australia and UWA Student Guild are committed to ensuring all members of the University Community are able to work and study in a safe environment that is free from danger, intimidation and harassment.

The 2020 UWA Safer Communities Award recognises the successes of key individuals or teams who have delivered projects that aim to create a safe, inclusive and supportive environment at the University in line with the UWA Student Experience Strategy – Experience UWA 2025.

Who can nominate?

Nominations are encouraged from individuals or teams across all areas of the University and its affiliates, including the Student Guild, and College Row. Students and staff are both invited to apply.

Nominations are also invited for collaborative projects between teams. Preference will be given to individuals or projects whose contributions extend beyond their usual core business.

There are two categories for this award:

Student award – for current students or student-led initiatives

Staff award – for current UWA, College or Guild staff or projects

Eligibility criteria:

- a. Projects or individuals must demonstrate commitment to promoting safety, health or inclusion across the UWA environment (this can include the University's online spaces).
 - i. Examples of safety and wellbeing focus areas can include: personal safety, inclusivity, mental health and wellbeing, sexual assault and harassment, disrespectful behavior, risky alcohol or other drug use or others..

And

- b. Initiatives or individuals may target concerns using **one or several** of the following methods:
 - A. Policy development;
 - i. Such as development or improvement of guiding policies and procedures that protect and support students.
 - B. Process and reporting;
 - i. Strategies that streamline referral pathways, increase reporting of incidents for sharing of data for continuous improvements to health and wellbeing services.
 - C. Environmental and structural measures;
 - i. Improvements to infrastructure or University environments to promote safety or inclusivity for students.
 - D. Prevention and cultural change strategies;
 - i. Education initiatives, training programs or events aiming to educate students or staff around health, safety or inclusivity topics.
 - E. Provision of support services;
 - i. Providing high quality services to support students or advocating for student needs. and/or
 - F. Communications and promotion.
 - i. Awareness raising campaigns, cross-collaborative promotion initiatives.

Nomination process:

- Individuals or groups can self-nominate or nominate others
- Nominations must be submitted in writing using the template provided
- Nominations must address the selection criteria above and demonstrate commitment to the safety and wellbeing of The University Community.

- o Please aim to demonstrate sustainability, impact, reach and commitment to diversity
- See the Award Nomination Template on page 3 for the questions that will form fields on Qualtrics.
- Supporting documents can be uploaded using the award portal. These can include videos, photos, testimonials, letters of endorsement or other documentation to support the nomination.
- Nominations must be submitted via the online form provided, **by 5:00pm Friday 16 October 2020**. No late submissions will be accepted.
