

Please check your exam timetable in studentConnect on Friday 5 February. If one of your exams in the period 15 to 19 February 2021 is Online Exemplify (ExamSoft) exam, please follow the below instructions.

- If you have **previously sat an Exemplify exam** and would like to familiarise yourself with Exemplify you can sit the Mock and practice exams again however this is not compulsory.
- If you have **never sat an Exemplify exam** you will need to complete the UWA Exemplify Mock Exam. In order to sit an Exemplify exam you need to install the software and complete the UWA Exemplify Mock Exam. This is a compulsory step for Exemplify exams.

The UWA Exemplify Mock Exam helps you familiarise yourself with the system and check technical requirements, and establishes your ID in preparation for your exams. It takes 10 minutes, *is a generic exam for all students and is not marked*, and will be available from **now** up until **12 noon (AWST) Friday, 19 February 2021**.

We are confident that Exemplify is a responsible platform to use in order to ensure integrity of assessment and with respect to your privacy. Our [FAQs](#) are regularly updated to help you stay informed so we encourage you to explore these. We want to re-assure you again, that **if you remain concerned about Exemplify you can opt-out of online Exemplify exams** provided that you email us via [askUWA](#) (selecting 'Examination Timetable' as your enquiry type in the form) by **Tuesday, 9 February 2021** and let us know that you are opting out of online Exemplify exams. All your Exemplify exams will be rescheduled to face to face exams when we are able to schedule face to face exams again. We are unable to provide you with a date for these rescheduled exams at this point, due to government restriction. **Please note it is not possible to opt out of LMS assessments.**

#### **WHAT YOU NEED TO DO - If you have not used Exemplify for a previous exam:**

##### **1. Download Exemplify and register an account.**

If you don't already have Exemplify on your device, please use the credentials below to download Exemplify in order to take your exams:

1. You will receive an email to your UWA email address from [exambot@examsoft.com](mailto:exambot@examsoft.com) inviting you to login to ExamSoft. (N.B Check your junk mail if no email is received to your Inbox)
2. Click on the Login link and this will redirect you to a UWA login page where you will need to enter your UWA credentials (Student Number and PHEME password).
3. From here you will have the option to download Exemplify for either a Mac or PC.
4. Follow the prompts to create an account.
5. **You will not be able to successfully log into ExamSoft if you try to log in by using your email and password.**

##### **2. Download the UWA Exemplify Mock Exam**

Your UWA Exemplify Mock Exam will be ready for download when you log in.

##### **3. Sit the UWA Exemplify Mock Exam**

The UWA Exemplify Mock Exam will be available for you to sit from **now until 12 noon (AWST) Friday, 19 February 2021**.

It takes 10 minutes to complete from the time you commence.  
To start your mock exam you will need the password **cPM9Db**

Please note, for the final exams, your password will be emailed to you to your student email at least 15 minutes before the scheduled start time of the exam. It will also be visible on the [UWA exams website](#).

4. **UWA Mock Exam baseline photo.**

You do not need your Student ID for this because the system captures your image for ID verification. All exams you subsequently sit will capture an image which will check against this image as part of the ID verification before you start any exam.

You will need to have a webcam enabled computer to capture the image.

Please note that **you are not permitted** to wear hats, caps, earplugs and headphones when sitting the UWA Mock Exam as this is not permitted in the exam.

5. You will have the opportunity to download and sit the UWA Mock Exam a maximum of 20 times during the exam window.
