

2021 UWA Safer Communities Award Information Sheet

The University of Western Australia and UWA Student Guild are committed to ensuring all members of the University Community are able to work and study in a safe environment that is free from danger, intimidation and harassment.

The 2021 UWA Safer Communities Award aims to recognise the continued commitment and dedication of staff, students, student clubs and societies, and partners who go above and beyond to create a safe, inclusive and supportive community at The University in line with the UWA Student Experience Strategy – Experience UWA 2025.

Who can nominate?

- You can nominate individuals or teams across all areas of the University, Student Guild, and College Row.
- Students and staff are encouraged to nominate others.
- Nominations are also invited for collaborative projects between teams.
- Nominations should aim to demonstrate commitment that extends beyond an individual/team's usual core business or role.

Eligibility criteria:

- Projects or individuals demonstrate commitment to promoting safety, wellbeing or inclusion across the UWA environment (this can include the University's online spaces).
 - Examples of safety, wellbeing and inclusivity focus areas could include: personal safety, inclusivity, anti-racism, mental health and wellbeing, sexual assault and harassment, disrespectful behavior, risky alcohol or other drug use.
- Examples of programs or contributions could include:
 - o Cultural change initiatives, training programs or events on health, safety or inclusivity topics.
 - o Provision of high-quality and approachable services to support students.
 - o Advocating for emerging student needs.
 - o Awareness raising campaigns or cross-collaborative promotion initiatives.
 - Development or improvements to policies and procedures that protect and support students.
 - o Initiatives that streamline referral pathways or access to support.
 - Improvements to infrastructure or University environments to promote safety or inclusivity.

Nomination process:

- UWA students or staff can nominate individuals, student clubs and societies, or teams who have gone above and beyond to create a safe, inclusive and supportive community.
- Nominations must be submitted using the online portal via the Safer Communities web page.
- See the Award Nomination Template on page 3 for the questions that will form fields on the Award Nomination Portal. Incomplete submissions in the portal will not be saved.
- Supporting documents can be uploaded using the award portal. These can include videos, photos, testimonials, letters of endorsement or other documentation to support the nomination.
- Nominations must be submitted via <u>the online form provided</u>, by 5:00pm Thursday 30 September 2021. No late submissions will be accepted.
