

# Master of Architecture (96 points) 2020 Enrolment Guide

The Master of Architecture course (for students with an Architectural background) is 96 points or 2 years full time. Students who have not completed a Bachelor degree with majors in Architecture or equivalent as recognised by the School of Design, must complete relevant conversion units up to the value of 72 points. Student will complete core units, required studio units and option units from groups A, B and C to a total of 72 points and then choose a further 24 points of elective units from option groups A, B and C. Students who would like to focus on studio can take additional studio units.
