

UWA Fee Increases



On a student's COE, the maximum possible fees are outlined, however the actual fees that a student pays may be less than this amount.

UWA Course fees increase over time, but this fee increase will not exceed 7.5% per annum.

How fees are calculated



Student applies for Postgraduate course in 2017
Master of Strategic Communication (2 years / 96 points)
Fees are \$32,000 pa in 2017 (for 48 points)



Student commences study in 2018
2018 fees increase to \$34,400 pa (for 48 points)
 $\$32,000 \times 1.075 = \$34,400$



On the COE fees are estimated for the entire course - with maximum increase of 7.5% pa used to calculate the 2018 & 2019 fees
COE states that Course Fees (96 points) are \$71,380
 $\$34,400 + (\$34,400 \times 1.075) = \$71,380$



When actual fees are calculated they are likely to increase by less than the maximum rate, and students will only be charged for the actual increase
As there is no increase in course fees for 2019, the COE states that Course Fees are \$71,380, but the student will only be charged \$68,800
 $\$34,400 + \$34,400 = \$68,800$
