

- WA International Baccalaureate (IB) students

Eligible courses*

Students may use the predicted ATAR pathway to apply for admission to the following.

- Any of our undergraduate degrees
- Combined Bachelor's and Master's degrees
- Non-quota limited Assured Pathways to Law, Teaching, Architecture, Landscape Architecture, Public Health and Translation Studies.

The Predicted ATAR entry pathway is not applicable for Assured Pathways to Medicine, Dentistry, Pharmacy and Podiatric Medicine. The courses are not available for Early Offers, since they are quota-restricted.

STAT pathway is only available for entry to the following courses.

- Bachelor of Arts
- Bachelor of Biomedical Science
- Bachelor of Business
- Bachelor of Commerce
- Bachelor of Environmental Design

- Bachelor of Music (Music is a specialist degree but is eligible through STAT subject to audition)
- Bachelor of Science (the Mathematics and Statistics Major and the Physics Major are subject to prerequisite requirements)

Application dates and process

Year 12 students can apply for any of the eligible courses from **Monday**, **4 April 2022** and applications will close on **Friday**, **16 December 2022**.

Students can either:

- <u>Apply directly to UWA</u> for non-quota courses (including Assured Pathways into Architecture, Landscape Architecture, Law, Public Health, Translation Studies and Teaching); or
- Apply to TISC for quota restricted courses (including Assured Pathways into Medicine, Dentistry, Pharmacy and Podiatry).

UWA does not charge students any fees for a domestic application; however, there is a one-time \$80 TISC application fee for domestic undergraduate applications for 2023 intake. TISC services are engaged as an input to admission assessments.

If a student has already paid the \$80 TISC fee for their initial application, there will be no further charges for changing preferences, regardless of whether the student applied directly to UWA or through TISC.

Students may also wish to visit the <u>UWA Early Offers FAQs</u> and register their interest to stay up to date with information on the application process.

Broadway UWA

The <u>Broadway scheme</u> allows eligible students from a Broadway-identified Western Australian school to receive an automated ATAR adjustment if the school at which they completed their final WACE examinations:

- <u>is identified as a Broadway school in their year of application</u> or
- was identified as a Broadway school in the year the student completed their WACE
