Your personal statement should be no more than 1200 – 1400 words.

#### 1) Communication and relational capabilities

Provide evidence and examples to demonstrate that you have excellent oral and written communication skills in English, and that you have the ability to build and maintain respectful relationships with people from a range of backgrounds and age groups.
