About the scholarship

UWA's undergraduate fee discount scholarships will be awarded to eligible students from India, who have demonstrated high academic achievement in their high school studies and who have been accepted to undertake a Bachelor's degree at UWA, commencing in 2017, 2018 and 2019.

Eligibility

The scholarship would be awarded to students who meet the criteria outlined below:

- Be a citizen of India;
- Have achieved an equivalent ATAR¹ of at least 85 in previous studies used for entry in the University;
- Be enrolled, or eligible to enrol, full-time in an undergraduate degree course;
- All India Senior School Certificate (CBSE) issued by the Central Board of Secondary Education;
- Indian School Certificate (CISCE) issued by the Council for Indian School Certificate Examination;
- International Baccalaureate Diploma (IB) and GCE A-Levels schools in India;
- Have completed high school studies which are affiliated with the following boards:

Conditions

- **Duration:** The Scholarship applies for the total duration of studies at UWA in the applicable course (as stated in student's offer letter).
- **Load:** The reduced fee only applies if students maintain a 100% load (normally 48 points), and will not be extended if a student does not complete within the total course duration stated on their offer letters.

Method of payment

The scholarship is:

- Provided as a fee reduction towards the recipient's eligible course fees; and
- Applied to the recipient's course fees in two equal instalments each year, one each semester.

Criteria for continuation

The recipient must:

- Continue to meet the eligibility requirements;
- Remain enrolled full-time;
- Make satisfactory progress in accordance with the rules for the course for which the Scholarship is awarded; and
- Confirm twice annually, in the manner and by the dates specified by the University, that they continue to meet the eligibility requirements of the scholarship.

¹ An equivalent ATAR is determined by UWA Admissions from previous studies used for entry into the University.
