



UWA International Achievement Scholarship China

About the Scholarship

The UWA International Achievement Scholarship will be awarded to high-achieving undergraduate and postgraduate students with Chinese citizenship who apply for selected courses within the study areas of Commerce, Engineering, Computer Science and Data Science.

Eligibility

Eligible students are those who:

- are a Chinese citizen and meet the criteria for entry at UWA;
- are commencing an eligible undergraduate or postgraduate coursework degree within the study areas of Commerce, Engineering, Computer Science or Data Science at the University in Semester 2, 2019

Award details

The scholarship is a fee discount for a maximum of one semester as specified in the letter of offer.

Value

The value of the Scholarship is determined by the applicant's Gao Kao score or equivalent UWA weighted average mark (WAM) as shown in the table below.

How to apply

Eligible applicants to the University will be automatically considered for the Scholarship and do not need to submit a separate application.

Method of payment

The scholarship is provided as a one off fee discount towards eligible course fees for a maximum of one semester.

Conditions

- The offer of the Scholarship must be accepted by the date specified in the letter of offer.
- If the offer is not accepted within 30 days of the offer being made, the offer of the Scholarship may be withdrawn at the University's discretion.
- The Scholarship may not be held concurrently with any other UWA scholarship or award.

Criteria for continuation:

The student must:

- continue to meet the eligibility requirements of these conditions; and
- make satisfactory progress in accordance with the rules for the course for which the Scholarship is awarded;
