

About the Scholarship

The UWA International Achievement Scholarship will be awarded to high-achieving undergraduate and postgraduate students with Sri Lankan citizenship who apply for selected courses within the study areas of Commerce, Engineering, Computer Science and Data Science.

Award details

The Scholarship is an annual tuition fee discount for the normal full time duration of the awardee's course as specified in their letter of offer¹. The value of the Scholarship is determined by the applicant's equivalent Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR)² or UWA weighted average mark (WAM).

¹The duration of the advanced standing scholarship capped at a maximum of one semester.

Eligibility

Eligible students are those who:

- are a Sri Lankan citizen and meet the criteria for entry at UWA;
- are commencing an eligible undergraduate or postgraduate coursework degree within the of study areas of Commerce, Engineering, Computer Science or Data Science at the University in Semester 1, 2019 or Semester 2, 2019; and
- have not submitted previous university study for credit towards their intended degree course at the University, except for under approved articulation agreements.

How to apply

Eligible applicants to the University will be automatically considered for the Scholarship and do not need to submit a separate application.

Method of payment

The Scholarship is provided as a fee discount towards eligible course fees, with half the annual value allocated each semester.

Conditions

- The offer of the Scholarship must be accepted by the date specified in the letter of offer.
- If the offer is not accepted within 30 days of the offer being made, the offer of the Scholarship may be withdrawn at the University's discretion.
- The Scholarship may not be held concurrently with any other scholarship or award.

Criteria for continuation:

The student must:

- not apply for advanced standing or post-admission credit;
- continue to meet the eligibility requirements of these conditions; and
- make satisfactory progress in accordance with the rules for the course for which the Scholarship is awarded.

 $^{^{3}}$ An equivalent ATAR is determined by UWA Admissions having regard to the previous study used to gain entry into the University. Equivalent scores may vary occasionally.

³Advanced standing scholarships will only be awarded for Semester 2, 2019 applications.
