Critical Information Summary

Title and brief description	PHCYM417 Pharmacist Immunisation Certification. This micro-credential provides Pharmacists registered with the Pharmacy Board of Australia (PBA) with the clinical competence to practice as a pharmacist immunisation provider for approved vaccines in line with Western Australia legislation. Pharmacists will a) complete online and face to face components, and b) provide evidence of externally completed components (including current first aid, CPR and anaphylaxis training), to be issued with certification for pharmacist immunisation.
Certified learning	(1) demonstrate an understanding of immunisation as outlined in the National Immunisation Education Framework for Health Professionals; (2) demonstrate clinical competence in the complete vaccine administration process as outlined in the Australian Immunisation Handbook including pre-vaccination screening process, injection techniques (Intramuscular and subcutaneous), preparation of vaccines, post vaccination care and documentation; (3) state the management of anaphylaxis and differentiate between vasovagal and anaphylaxis; and (4) describe the practical elements of implementing a pharmacist immunisation service.
