Title and brief description	BCHNM100 Gateway to Business Mandarin. The lessons include general Mandarin knowledge and essential language skills for business engagement. Under the capability-oriented principle, the course focuses on developing the learners' listening and speaking skills and gradually improving their reading ability. By learning various relevant business topics, learners will obtain practical knowledge in both professional language and business culture.
Certified learning	(1) understand about 250 vocabulary words and basic grammatical knowledge; (2) apply basic expressions like greetings, farewell, appreciation and apologies, etc; (3) appropriately use dates, times, locations and directions, making relevant inquiries; (4) make meeting appointments and book a ticket/hotel/Taxi; and (5) obtain essential cultural knowledge and skills.
