Title and brief description	GENDM301 Relational Practice and the Politics of Gender/Sex. Negotiating gender/sex differences in institutional settings currently demands skilled stewards of dialogue, with an informed understanding of theories and experiences of gender/sex. Dialogue is an intentional form of interaction predicated on a relational worldview, which sees reality as constituted through relationships or interactions. This unit will support leaders or communicators from any field to host productive interactions about gender/sex and sexuality.
